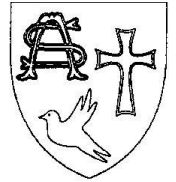

If you would like to buy some small envelopes to put your money in then you can get hold of them at the office at £2.50 for 50. It is important to keep up to date with your dinner payments as we **do not** offer a credit system. If you think you may qualify for Free School Meals then please come to the office to discuss. If you are unable to meet any of the payments then we will ask you to bring in a packed lunch until the debt is paid.

**FREE SCHOOL MEALS** - If you think you are eligible for free school meals could you please claim even if at times the children do not wish to have the meal. The school is given a considerable amount of money for each free school meal claimed which will benefit your child's education. Mrs Edwards, School Secretary has the details and is more than willing to help you fill in the form online.
