FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Following consultations between Catechists, Fr Abraham and Mr Morgan it has been decided that there will not be First Holy Communion in May/June 2018. The reason for this decision is that there are no children in years 3 & 4 currently regularly attending Mass on a Sunday and participating in Children's Liturgy. It is expected that First Holy Communion for children in years 3 & 4 will next take place in May/June 2019 and the preparation programme for this will commence at the end of November 2018. Should parents wish their children to make their First Holy Communion in May/June 2019 they will need to demonstrate their commitment to their child receiving the sacrament by attending Sunday Mass with their children on a regular basis commencing now. Preparing children to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion is demanding for Catechists and preparation is more difficult for children who do not regularly attend Sunday Mass or participate in Children's Liturgy at Mass.
