## REMOTE LEARNING UPDATE

The first minister for Wales confirmed that pupils will contine to learn remotely until at least January 29<sup>th</sup>. It is however highly likely that schools will continue working remotely until February half term. Vulnerable children and children of Critical workers will contine to have access to face to face teaching. The required provision for vulnerable children and children of critical workers has been clarified and is now until 3.15 pm and not 4.00 pm.
