From the 1st March 2021, all school grounds in Wales will become smoke free spaces. As Wales becomes the first country in the UK to extend its smoking ban to certain outdoor areas, we are committed to improving the health of our staff and pupils by providing a smoke free environment.

Smoking in smoke free spaces – which not only includes school grounds but also public, outdoor day-care and child- minding settings as well as hospital grounds from the 1^{st} March could result in £100 fine.

We want to protect everyone from harmful second-hand smoke and we especially recognise the important role that adults have in influencing the attitudes and smoking behaviour of children and young people. Banning smoking in places where children and young people spend their time will denormalise smoking and reduce the chances of children and young people starting smoking in the first place - ultimately saving lives.
