HEAD LICE - There are head lice in the school again. Please check your child's hair on a regular basis to avoid these little pests. For further information and support please feel free to contact our school nurse on 01244 532337

HOW TO DETECT HEAD LICE/WET COMBING

METHOD

- 1) After shampooing hair apply hair conditioner and using a detection comb touch the scalp and comb through hair. Wipe on kitchen paper and see if live lice are present.
- 2) Continue in this way until all the head has been combed, thoroughly.
- 3) Wash out all conditioner, towel dry hair and use detection comb again without conditioner - stray lice may be caught at this time.
- 4) This procedure will need to be done on all family members at least once every week and takes about 15 minutes.

TREATMENTS

If you find live Head Lice then a suitable treatment needs to be applied twice 7 days apart and left on for 12 hours and then washed off. Head Lice Treatments can be obtained from your Doctor, Health Visitor or Chemist.

Do not apply treatments if no live lice are seen.
