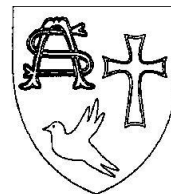

### SCHOOL COMMS/GATEWAY - MEAL SELECTION.

As you will be aware there is now a new way to order school meals. We have moved over to Cypad Meal Manager within the school gateway app.

\*The Cypad Meal Manager System allows parents to pre-book and pay for their child's meals at home - up to 3 weeks in advance

\*If parents miss the cut off of 8am on the day to order their meal, pupils can still order in class in the morning. It is important to note that if your child/children are going to be late and you have not ordered your child's lunch via the app then you must phone/email school before 9:30am. Dinners cannot be ordered by us after this point.

EARLY ENTITLEMENT - We can take children the term after their third birthday into nursery for four days a week, 9.00 - 11.30. Therefore, if your child was 3 before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024 they can start now or if they have their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> April they can start after Easter.
