ATTEND AND ACHIEVE! - Whole school attendance for this week is: 89.7% Please remember to phone school when your child is off to let us know or it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. Our school target is 96%.



SCHOOL DINNERS - REMINDER. If your child/ren are going to be late and you wish to order a school meal you can order via the Cpad app and pre-order school meals yourself. However, it must be done before 9.30am on the day. You can also phone or email us and let us know before 9.30am so that we can order it for you. While we will always endeavour to provide our pupils with a meal we cannot guarantee they will be able to have their preferred choice if they are late.

EARLY ENTITLEMENT - We can take children the term after their third birthday into nursery for four days a week, 9.00 - 11.30. Therefore, if your child has already turned 3 they may be able to attend straight away.
