****Very importantly, if you are applying to a school in Cheshire for example Catholic high or Kings school Chester you need to apply to them directly.**

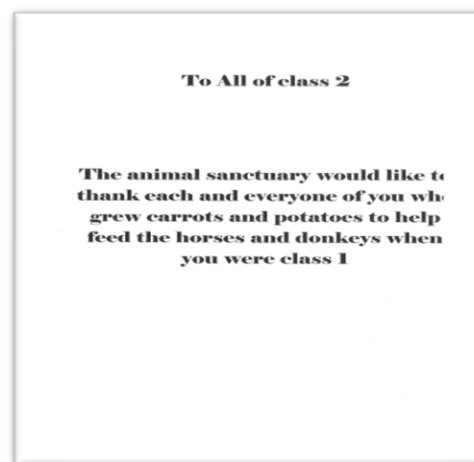
GENTLE REMINDERS;
