Parents, guardians and family members welcome.



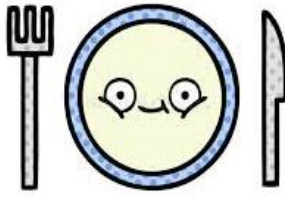
