Courses will be held via Zoom

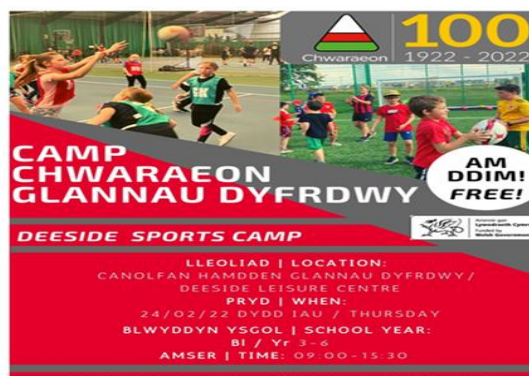
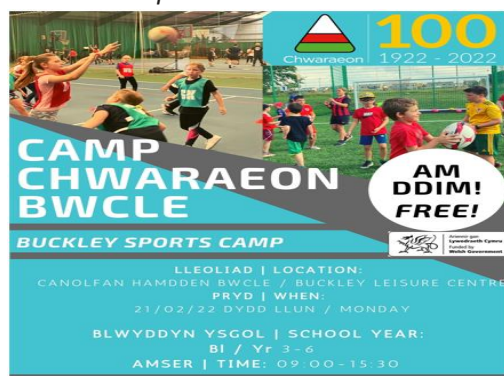
