GET TALKING SUMMER CHALLENGE!

The **Get Talking Summer Challenge** invites parents and carers across Wales to complete one fun five-minute activity a day with their child to help boost their speech, language and communication skills.

These activities include things like talking, reading and playing together to help develop foundational skills which will set them up for life. For some children, the challenge will provide them with a great head start for nursery or their return to school in September, with coronavirus restrictions

during the pandemic having limited opportunities to socialise and interact with others.
