We are not taking part in the national Christmas jumper day as we have already supported many charities this term.

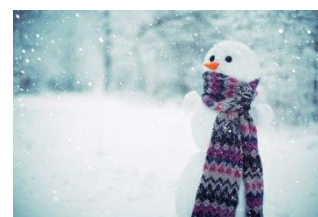
The BHF Elf Kick
