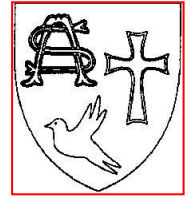

**ADMISSION TO SECONDARY SCHOOL 2023**



All year 6 parents can apply for their child's secondary school place by applying online at [www.flintshire.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.flintshire.gov.uk/schooladmissions). Closing date for applications is November 4<sup>th</sup> 2022.

\*\*Very importantly, if you are applying to a school in Cheshire for example Catholic high or Kings school Chester you need to apply to them directly.

**WRAP AROUND CARE** - Our Wrap around care is now fully registered with the Care Inspectorate Wales. We can take nursery children aged 3 to 4 years from 7.50 am at breakfast club all the way through to afterschool club at 5.30pm. Nursery aged children can apply for Government funded childcare to cover costs, for eligible working parents. If not the cost of Wrap around is a very reasonable £5.00 per hour from 11.30 to 3.15pm. If you know of anyone who need a nursery place, please sign post them to our lovely family community school.
